Self-directed activities in zip lock bags

Prepare your classroom for a whole week of Thanksgiving celebration.

Have your classroom ready with typical decorations. Prepare a beautiful bulletin board with leaves in different colors, Thanksgiving posters and children made crafts.

You can find many ideas on the internet.

Hanging Thanksgiving decorations

Make turkey hanging decorations. Use plastic cups, paper rolls or cylinders made out of construction paper, feathers and strips of construction paper or ribbon in Fall colors. Cover the paper cups and paper rolls with brown construction paper or paint them. Glue googly eyes a beak and wattle from orange and red construction paper and attach them with glue. Glue the feathers on the inside at the top and the ribbons on the bottom as shown in the picture. To hang the turkey decoration, poke 2 small holes in the top, thread a string through them, and knot them.

Greet everyone with an enthusiastic Happy Thanksgiving week as they arrive.

Before you start your class set a table with bags with self-directed activities for Thanksgiving. Invite children to choose a bag and to carry out the activity.

Provide some time for children to carry out the activities while they greet each other and work cooperatively at the tables' area.

After a few minutes, stop the music and invite children to sit at the Circle Time area. Tell the group that they will be celebrating Thanksgiving during the week.

Theme Focus

Tema

Thanksgiving Day/Día de Acción de Gracias

Begin by telling children a little bit about the Thanksgiving celebration. Tell them that "Thanksgiving Day is celebrated on the fourth Thursday of the month of November in the United States. Families and friends get together to share and enjoy a huge feast and give thanks for all the good things in life. On this day they commemorate the party celebrated by the pilgrims who arrived from England on 1621 to thank the native Americans for helping them survive. In this party they shared a big buffet with turkey, fish, vegetables, fruits and corn dishes."

"El día de Acción de Gracias se celebra el cuarto jueves de cada noviembre en Estados Unidos. Las familias y los amigos se reúnen para compartir un gran banquete y dar gracias por todas las cosas buenas de la vida. En ella compartieron un gran banquete que contenía, carnes de pavo, pescado, verduras, frutas y preparaciones a base de maíz."

A beak for the turkey/Un pico para el pavo

Prepare a large picture of a turkey with a big beak. You may want to decorate your door for this project (See Appendix).

Cut out a paper beak for each player with his or her name on it. Place a little bit of blue tack on the back of each beak.

Hang the turkey on a wall or a door where there is lots of space around it.

Explain to children that they will take turns at placing the beak on the turkey blindfolded.

Have each child take a turn and try to place the beak on the turkey. The child who places the beak closest to the real one is the winner.

You may want to laminate the picture of the turkey and the noses.

You can also play this fun game with the pilgrims, the Indians or a scarecrow on the door. Play “Put a nose to pilgrims, the Indians/Natives or a scarecrow!” “Pon una nariz a los peregrinos, los indios/nativos o a un espantapájaros!”

Put a beak to the turkey game

Decorate your doors with Thanksgiving turkeys such as the ones below. Kids will enjoy by helping make a turkey beak out of folded sticky notes with their names. If you like you may put some double-sided tape on the back of each note. Then blindfold each child. Invite him/her to try to place the beak on the proper space on the turkey.



Variation:

Have children cut out circles for noses for the pilgrim, the Indians and the Scarecrow.

Arts & Crafts Activities

Actividades de Arte y Manualidades

Play dough turkeys/Pavos de plastilina

Children love playing with dough and making all kinds of figures. Give some pieces of brown dough to the children and let them explore and express their creativity. Encourage them to imagine and create turkeys with their play dough.

Keep in mind that when children play with dough they are developing and strengthening their small muscles and refining their fine motor skills. They are using their imagination to create and innovate. They are experimenting with concepts such as size, shape, length and weight.

Place a few arts and crafts materials to make the experience more enjoyable.

Materials:

Play dough in different colors

Pipe cleaners in different sizes and colors

Wiggly eyes in different sizes

Plastic trays or plates. One for each child to keep their dough on it.

In case you would like to make the dough following is a safe an easy recipe.

Materials:

4 cups of plain flour

Thanksgiving-Acción de Gracias

1 1/2 cups of salt

2 tbs. of oil

1 cup of warm water

A few drops of food coloring of your choice (4 different colors)

5 medium mixing bowls

Use 4 bowls for mixing the ingredients and making 4 different colors of play dough. Pour 1/4 cup of water into each of these bowls. Add a few drops of different food color to each bowl. Add ½ tablespoon of oil to each bowl as well. Stir.

Use the left bowl to mix the flour with the salt. Stir all together.

Next, pour 1 cup of the dry mixture into each bowl. Stir and mix all in. Once it is all mixed put the mixture on a cutting board and knead until it is nice and smooth. Put the play dough in plastic bags and keep them in the refrigerator.

Thanksgiving Sorting

Use craft punches to cut out pieces of Thanksgiving images from construction paper. Give each child a bowl of assorted paper cutouts. Have them sort the paper cutouts onto the sorting sheet and glue them on.

Use Thanksgiving plastic toys. Give each child a bowl of assorted toys. Have them sort the toys onto bowls for each toy.

Use orange, black and yellow pom-poms or any other arts and crafts materials (buttons, sticks, colored pasta) for children to sort by color or type of material.


Matching activities

Game cards for matching by number, color, shapes, etc.

Thanksgiving Patterns

Use turkey, pilgrim hat, leaves and feathers craft punches to cut out the pieces from construction paper. Children glue the cutouts on a paper pattern strip following AB, AABB, ABC, ABB, AAB, etc.

Place colored pasta or colored beads for children to make a Thanksgiving Indian necklace following a pattern, such as the ones presented by Early Learning Ideas.

Turkey Activities

Hand print turkey

Materials:

- Turkey body template
- Orange, red, brown and yellow construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Googly eyes



What to do:

1. Have children trace their hands using different colors of construction paper. Have them cut them out.
2. Prepare the body of the turkey template as indicated in following next page.

3. Have children color it.

Ask children to glue the traced and cut out hands on the back of the turkey's body to make the feathers.

4. Finally, ask them glue some googly eyes and a beak to the turkey's face.

You can also have children use real feathers or colored feathers or autumn leaves to complete the turkey. See the samples below:



Encourage children to cut out the skeleton pieces and to put them together with fasteners.


